I live off McKean Road in the South Almaden Valley Urban Reserve and witness the peak hour traffic on McKean Road through Bailey Road and up Almaden Expressway. Our current problem is that we have old country roads that connect at one end to Highway 101 @ Bailey Rd. and at the Northern end connects to Almaden Expressway that eventually makes it's way to the Highway 85 onramp.

My point is that Bailey Road and McKean road and the Southern narrow stretch of Almaden Expressway are connectors of the future Coyote Valley Developments to the greater City of San Jose via our neighborhood. What is planned for mitigations for the increased traffic.
