

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The City Council of the City of San José will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, February 27, 2007** to accept the Draft Coyote Valley Specific Plan Water Supply Evaluation (DWSE) prepared for the project identified below, as required by California State law. This Public Hearing will be held in accordance with the San José Municipal Code.

The Public Hearing is to be in the City Council Chambers, on the second floor of City Hall Wing, at 200 East Santa Clara Street, San José, California, at **1:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as this item can be heard. You are welcome to attend and to speak on this issue.

The project being considered is the Draft **WATER SUPPLY EVALUATION** for the Coyote Valley Specific Plan as prepared by the City as the Lead Agency. The DWSE provides detailed information regarding water availability for the potential development of a minimum of 25,000 residential units and 50,000 new industry-driving jobs in Coyote Valley. The DWSE has been prepared as required by and in conformance with California State law (SB 610) and, with the Council's acceptance, will be included for analysis in the Draft Environmental Impact Report for the Coyote Valley Specific Plan.

The DWSE is available for review Monday to Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Department of Planning, Building and Code Enforcement (PBCE), 200 East Santa Clara Street, San José, and is also available on the PBCE web site at (www.sanjoseca.gov/coyotevalley/EIR.html).

It should be noted that the acceptance of the Draft Water Supply Evaluation (DWSE) does not constitute final approval of the DWSE or approval of the Coyote Valley Specific Plan project for which it was prepared, nor does its acceptance denote a particular retail water supplier to serve CVSP. The decision to approve or deny the project will be made separately as required by City Ordinance.
